Definition of networking


1 : the exchange of information or services among individuals, groups, or institutions





Always be authentic









Go with a buddy Avoid in-jokes(inside jokes)

• Better

Politely excuse yourself

• Best

Take time when you need it. Remember it's not a race, or a marathon, it's your career!

Starting or joining conversation

• Good

Say hi, and gauge their response

• Better

Ask an interesting question

• Best

Ask to join the conversation

Apologize


• Better

• Good



Asking for advice, input, or material review

• Better

Be respectful of others' time

Individual follow up messages

• Best

Provide a concise question and your reason for wanting to meet up




Wrapping up
