












#### The Journey














# Timetable

## FALL

- Release latest game





# Green Light Process

- Rotating Green Light committee
- Before pitching a game, run several internal play test sessions.
- Games don't need to be digital to be pitched, but we need to be able to play something.
- Pitch results for all games are posted for the whole company.

# Selection Criteria

- Appeals to a wide audience
- Fits the brand of Jackbox Games and The Jackbox Party Pack
- Has a lot of excitement/passion within the studio. Would be fun to work on.
- Is funny and makes people laugh
- Encourages social interaction gets people talking
- Has a low barrier to entry easy to understand, pick up, and play
- Does something new within the Party Pack format
- Doesn't work better as a card game or board game or mobile game
- Isn't too similar to another game we have made or are making (especially a game in this particular pack)
- Engages audience in a new and/or meaningful way



# Pitch Results

## YELLOW LIGHT

- Game is good to go on to next stage:
- Preproduction
- Evaluate and assess production risks
- Identify game core and define creative brief.

- Neat idea, but revisit assumptions.
- Assign additional team members to address concerns.
- Repitch

## RED LIGHT

- Stop working on the game for this cycle.
- Possibly revisit again for the next pack.







# TeleFun Test #1 9/27/17

Players listened to an obscured VO file, wrote down what they thought was being said.

### RESULTS

Guessing the correct answer (which no one ever did) or hearing it revealed wasn't the fun. The fun was hearing the guesses.



### TeleFun Test #2 10/2/17

Similar to Fibbage where one player's response to a prompt is distorted and others guess what it said. All responses are read via text-to-speech.

### RESULTS

It was fun to hear the computer say what people wrote. Biggest laughs were the word "choad" and a few comments about Ryan and Mark





## Not Word Spud 2 Test #3 10/6/17

Each player was given a list of 2-5 parts of speech to provide: adjective, etc. Those words fill in the blanks of the first line of four poems.

### RESULTS

Figuring out a way to "gameify" it would help... I like the idea of it being competitive instead of collaborative... I'm interested in trying some sort of rap battle.



## CoupLet's Test #4 10/18/17

Players write parts of or an entire couplet. It's played back using a singing version of TTS with musical accompanyment.

### RESULTS

Singing robot was hard/impossible to understand. Try this with the entire first line filled in except the last word



## Rap Battle/Beat Poetry Test #4 10/27/17

Tested a beat poetry version and a rap battle version.

### RESULTS

Though both produced laughs, the Rap Battle felt more like a game.





## Rap Battle Test #5 10/31/17


I told them up front that the Mad Libs words would need to be rhymed to, so they should take care not to set themselves up for a tough writing task.




Scoring should maybe be a combo of voting by spectators mid-rap but also by voting post-rap.


